This is page one of the three pages of rules and guidelines that will apply to the kata, kumite, and team kata competition on Sunday, February 25, 2007. Please be sure these instructions are provided to all officials and competitors. Please direct any questions to the Santa Ana Dojo.

Tournament Structure

- Preregistration must be in by Saturday, February 24, 2007 at the following fee levels:
 - \$35 flat fee per person for kata and/or kumite divisions [to register at the door, \$35 for one event and \$50 for two events].
 - If a competitor preregistered for only kata or only kumite division wishes to add the second division at the door, the fee is \$15.
 - \$30 fee per team for team kata, \$45 at the door.
 - Make all checks payable to JKF.
- Each competitor may enter one individual kata, one individual kumite, one team kata.
- If a competitor participates in both kata and kumite, both divisions must be for the same age/rank – Check with Sensei if Special Circumstances raise questions.
- Divisions are determined by kyu rank, not belt color.
- Order and composition of divisions may change at the discretion of officials.
- A minimum of three (3) competitors are required for a division to compete. If there are less than three competitors, the division may be combined with next higher division.
- Awards will be given as follows:
 - Kata - medals for first, second, and third place.
 - Kumite - medals for first, second, two (2) third place competitors.
 - Team kata - medals for first, second, and third place.
- JKF reserves the right to refuse to allow participation to any individual.
- No refunds.

Kumite

- Divisions below Brown Belt will have five (5) referees in the ring, 1 head referee and 4 corner judges; Brown and Black Belts will have four (4) referees in the ring, 1 head referee and 3 side judges.
- Divisions below Brown Belt will have two (2) minute matches; Brown and Black Belts will have three (3) minute matches.
- Divisions below Brown Belt have no face contact allowed; Brown and Black Belts may have light touch contact to face.
- Continuous clock for all divisions, unless head referee stops time.
- Beginner level divisions may not receive points for face attacks.
- Gloves, mouthpiece, and groin protector (males) are required. Gloves will be provided, if needed.
- Divisions below Brown Belt may go to three (3) full points (Ippon) – 1 point per technique.
- Brown and Black Belt divisions may go to eight (8) full point *spread*. WKF rules for Ippon/Nihon/Sanbon scoring apply.
- Coaching of the competitors is **not** allowed - individuals who insist on coaching may be ejected from the tournament.
- Ties will go into enchosen (sudden death) with no time limit.
 - First point wins
 - Penalties carry over into enchosen.
- Penalties may be given as follows, and may be accelerated if warranted.
Two Categories for warnings/penalties, as listed below, per WKF rules.

If penalties are accelerated, subsequent penalties within that same Category must be more severe. A competitor that inflicts a critical injury must be disqualified.

1st Chukoku (warning)

2nd Keikoku (one point penalty)

3rd Hansoku Chui (one point penalty) **Brown and Black Belt divisions, two points.**

4th Hansoku (disqualification from match)

Kata

- All kata divisions will have four corner judges plus a head judge.
- Point scoring will be across two full points, generally 5.0 to 7.0 for beginner divisions, 6.0 to 8.0 for intermediate divisions, and 7.0 to 9.0 for advanced and Black Belt divisions.
- Competitors in the junior beginner and intermediate divisions (individual kata divisions K1 through K12) are allowed to start their kata over if they forget their place or stop their kata in the middle.

Individual Kata

All Adult and Junior Beginners (7th kyu and under, or less than one year of training)

Competitors may choose from the following:

Pinan 1-5, Heian 1-5, Gekisai-Dai-Ichi, Gekisai-Dai-Ni, Tensho, Kanshiwa, Sanchin

All Adult and Junior Intermediate (6th - 4th kyu, or one to two years of training)

Competitors may choose from the following:

Beginner katas plus Bassai-Dai, Rohai, Jitte, Jiin, Saifa, Kanshu

All Adult and Junior Advanced (3rd - 1st kyu, or over two years of training)

Competitors may choose any kata **EXCEPT (cannot do the following)**: Hakutsuru, Sansei-Ru, Shihochin, Tomari-Bassai, Chinshu, Sochin, Unsu, Supar-Rimpei, Nipai-Po, Seisan, Kururunfa, Seipai, Gojushiho, Matsumura-Bassai, Chatanyara-Kusan-Ku.

IF YOU HAVE QUESTIONS, BE SURE TO ASK TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR.

All Adult and Junior Black Belts: Competitors may choose any kata

Team Kata

- Each team must have three (3) members - either all junior or all adult - any mix of males and/or females – all from the same organization.
- Any formation is acceptable, but kata must begin and end in the same formation.
- Beginner division teams must be comprised of persons of no higher rank than 4th kyu; advanced division teams must be comprised of persons of no lower rank than 3rd kyu.
- No Pinan, Heian, or other beginner level katas may be performed in the advanced Team Kata divisions.
- Any kata performed must be appropriate for the level of the lowest ranked person on the team performing the kata.

Important Information

- Fees for competing
 - All Junior Students (Junior students may do kata only) - \$15.00.
 - Adults who do kata only - \$15.00.
 - Adults who do kata and cutting - \$40.00.
 - Three Person Team cutting - \$30.00 per team.
- No live (sharp) blades may be used for kata under Black Belt Batto-Do rank.
- All Sho-Dan and above competitors must use a live (sharp) blade for kata – use of Iai-Do blade will result in a penalty being applied to the competitor.
- All blades, both sharpened and not sharpened, must be brought by competitors and must pass inspection by Tai Kai officials.
- All Divisions are Mixed - competitors may be either female or male.
- All Black Belt competitors must wear Hakama (Japanese pants) and kimono top or gi top – Junior students and beginner competitors should also wear hakama, but may ask Sensei Demura for permission to wear a karate gi if he/she does not own a hakama.
- All competitors must have either bare feet or wear Tabi (Japanese socks).
- Kata competitors will each do three katas, and be paired for elimination.
- Cutting competitors and cutting teams will be paired for elimination – see rules for cutting requirements.
- Female competitors and division C-7 (non-Black Belt competitors) may use a “half mat” for cutting, if desired.
- All judging will be based on Japanese Tournament Standards.
- Divisions K-1 and K-3 are for competitors who have less than one year training with the sword.
- ***Divisions K-2 and K-4 are for competitors who have trained with the sword for more than one year, and who are not ranked as a Black Belt in Batto-Do.***
- ***Any unsafe action, improper use of sword, fooling around, or causing actual or potential harm to others will be cause for immediate expulsion from the competition.***
- ***In case of expulsion from the event, no spectator or competition fee will be refunded.***
- Please observe proper decorum at all times and show proper respect to judges, other tournament officials, and fellow competitors.
